## Day 01 ► La Paz

Arrival to this amazing city nestled at the foot of the Illimani Mountain which shows its characteristic contrasts.  
Assistance at the airport and transfer to selected **hotel**.  
Rest of day at leisure.

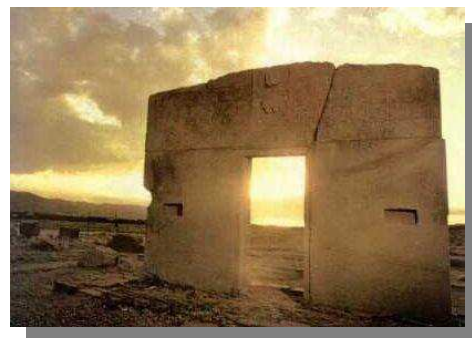
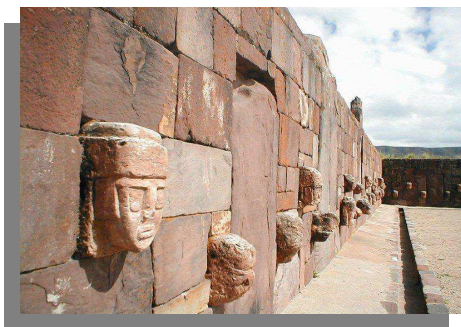

## Day 02 ► La Paz – Tiwanaku – La Paz City Tour

**Breakfast.** At previous set time **Excursion to the Archaeological Tiwanaku Center**, located at 72 Kilometers, 1 and a half hour trip from the city, Along the way we visit **Laja**, a small town where La Paz City was founded by the first time, its main square, the Sun Dial the Church with its baroque architecture of the XVII century; from **Llok'o Llok'o** .View of the impressive **Royal Andean Range** from the highest stop of the way,

Arrival to **Tiwanaku**, it shows a group of templar remains from Tiwanaku culture among them; **Kalasasaya Temple, Sun Gate, Semi subterranean Temple** with its **cabezas clavos** and the Barbado monolith, **Kantatallita, Putuni and Kericala remains**. You can also appreciate **Akapana pyramids** (not completely discovered yet, still being dig). This archaeological center is one of the oldest talking about Andean cultures and its remains amaze people for its monumental size and perfection in constructing and decorating. We can also find typical handicrafts, small stones carefully carved, based on monoliths, **Tiwanaku and Aymara charms**, as well as pottery highly carved such as **ceremonial vases, sahumadores**, and other great ones to offer the visitor. Return to La Paz.

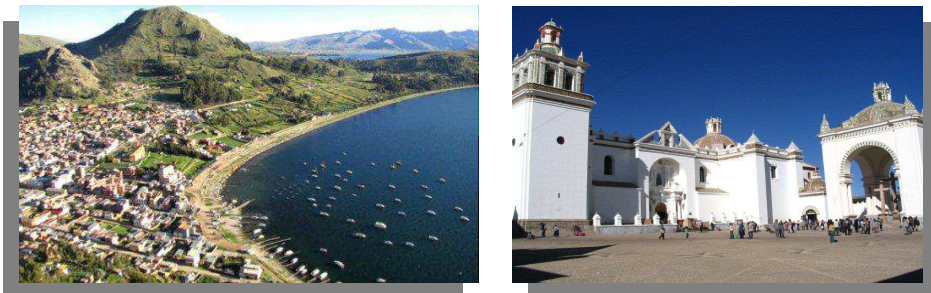


In the afternoon, **La Paz City tour** visiting the most important attractions of La Paz like: **Plaza Murillo, Government Palace, the Congress and the Cathedral; Customs, Gold, and Murillo's House Museums** on the well known Jaen Street; **Killi Killi Watchtower**, the **Witch Doctor's Market** where you will appreciate the different kinds of Bolivian handicrafts. Then visit the **San Francisco church, down town main districts** and specially the matchless **Moon Valley** where you will feel as you were in a small moon moor. (It lasts 3 ½ hours). Return to the hotel.

### Day 03 ► La Paz – Copacabana

**Breakfast.** At 08:00 leave to Copacabana an amazing town surrounding by Twin Mountains kindly located around the lake. Arrival to Copacabana where the stunning **Copacabana Virgin Temple** stands from the **brunette virgin image is venerated**, and then you go to the chosen hotel. **Lunch.**

During the afternoon we visit the **Main Town Square, Popular market, Handycrafts market**, return to the **Hotel. Dinner.**

### Day 04 ► Copacabana – Isla del Sol – Copacabana – La Paz

**Breakfast.** At 09:00 we will go to the port to take the motor boat to go to **Incas' Sacred Island**. The constructions in the southern part are particularly made, in **Yumani**, the Stone building called **Pillkokaina or Sun Palace**, remains of what was the Inca's house in this sacred island, its **stairs** that start in the shore until the an amazing **"Eternal Youth Fountain"** from which you can drink its sacred water. **Lunch.**

Small walks observing the amazing growing terraces. Descent to the shore to take the motor boat back to Copacabana and continue the trip back to La Paz.
