ITINERARY

Day 01: Asunción

Arrival to Asunción airport and transfer to selected hotel.

4 night accommodation at selected hotel in Asunción

Day 02: Asunción - City Tour

Tour "Discover Asunción" - 3 hours

During the morning: Discover Asunción, the "Mother of Cities", visiting the National Heroes Pantheon, the Independence House and its museum, the Central Post Office, the Metropolitan Cathedral, the old Parliament, the Government Palace, the new building of the Congress, the old Train Station with one of the first Steam Trains of South America, the Port, the Recova (typical market place of craftsmanship), the Lambaré Hill, the main residential neighborhoods, and "Mburuvichá Roga" (The Chief's House), the official residence of the Nation's President.



Cultural Tour - 3 hours

In this tour you will have the opportunity to visit the main museums of Asuncion. Historical museums of art, etnic in wich we can mention some of them: Independence House, Viola House-City Memorial, Clay Museum- Visual Arts Center, House of Culture, the Train Station and others more. Besides that, we take you to visit to the main Painting Galeries in where you can appreciate and also buy the best of Paraguayan Art. Encourage yourself and enjoy this tour!

Note: It doesn't include museums tickets.



Day 03: Asunción – Lago Ypacaraí

Lago Ypacarai Tour – Half day

This 4 hour tour will take you to the city of San Bernardino, which is located by the famous Lake Ypacaraí. On our way to San Bernardino we will be visiting the following cities: **Luque**: Established in 1636. Unmistakable signs of Luque are the gold and silver craftsmanship, leather and Karanda' y craftsmanship, music and the production of harps and guitars. **Aregua**: The distinctive landmarks of this pretty colonial town are its beautiful and calm landscapes, the Koi and Chororí Hills, its craftsmanship in clay and the production of strawberry. **Itaugua**: Established in 1728. This city is

famous for its "ÑANDUTI" weave, a cobweb like lace (tablecloths, table covers, dresses, etc.). **San Bernardino:** Is the summer city par excellence **Capiatá**: Its parish church is a jewel of the baroque art of the Franciscans. The hand carved altar was recently restored. Visitaremos también el Mueso Mitológico de Capiata.





Day 04: Asunción – Eco Adventure

La Quinta Ranch and Eco Adventure at Mbatovi Reserve – 7 hours

• Lunch included

Breakfast and early departure to Paraguarí, to enjoy a day full of adrenaline in the Eco-Reserve Mbatovi'. We will enjoy the tour of the Saingo tape (hanging path) that consists of a series of activities taking place at the height of the treetops and, in some cases above them. Total safety and guided fun with the support of specialized instructors and equipment of last generation with international certification. Includes Yvaropy Path tour, 2,000 meters in length, four suspension bridges; an amazing stretch of 105 meters Zip-line extension that allows you to "fly" over the forest 40 meters high, and rappelling a natural wall of over 20 meters high.

After the tour will have lunch at La Quinta Ranch, where we will also have time to enjoy the Paraguayan long naps.

Free afternoon to enjoy Ranch's activities or just relax in a typical hammock.

At night:

Dinner Show - 4 hours

We will take you from your hotel to a typical Paraguayan restaurant where you may enjoy the magnificent Paraguayan gastronomy and appreciate live typical music and dance. The cozy ambient, the Paraguayan Guitar, the Harp and the expressive dances, where the "Bottle Dance" exceeds, will turn this dinner in an unforgettable one.

This tour includes transfers from and to your hotel, dinner and show fee. Drinks are not included.





Day 05: Asunción - Encarnación

Early in the morning, transfer from the hotel to Asunción bus station. Departure on regular bus to Encarnación (arrival 2.00pm ETA)

During the afternoon,

Ruins of Trinidad and Jesús Tour

These ruins were appointed as "Cultural Patrimony of Mankind" and are the expression of the evangelizing work of the Jesuits. The Jesuit Museum offers carved stones and retables; and the Licit Museum offers licit material of the archeological research at the old Jesuit settlement. You may also visit the "Picada Boca", which is the quarry from where the stones used to build the ruins were extracted.



Transfer to the hotel.

2 night accommodation at selected hotel at Encarnación

Day 06: Encarnación

Day at leisure to enjoy the beach, stroll along the waterfront or shopping.



Day 07: Encarnación – Asunción

At suitable time, transfer to Encarnación bus station with destination Asunción. Arrival and transfer to Asunción airport.

END OF OUR SERVICES

If you want to complement your trip, we suggest a visit to the **Iguazu Falls** (Argentine and Brazilian sides) with a minimum of 2 or 3 night accommodation in Puerto Iguazu.

In this case, the route from Encarnación goes via Posadas city (Argentina) to Puerto Iguazu (about 320 km).
